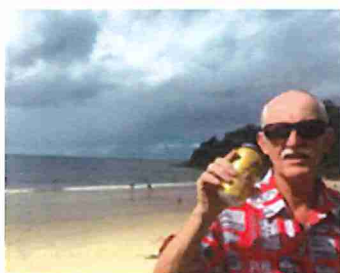

Season 2018 promises to be an exciting season for the Forest Hill Football Club following back to back Grand Final appearances in season 2016 and 2017. This year we have further enhanced the coaching staff and I would like to welcome to the club;

- Matthew Peterson will again coach the Reserves and will also look after the forwards in 2018.
- As well publicised our senior assistant coach Justin Scicluna will take over as the senior coach in 2019 in the club's success plan which gives the club enormous stability for next season and beyond.

Forest Hill netball started in 2015 with one team but has expanded and three teams will take the court on Friday nights in 2018.

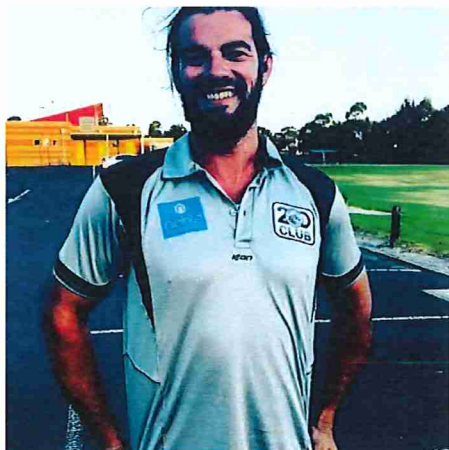

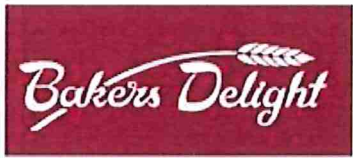
