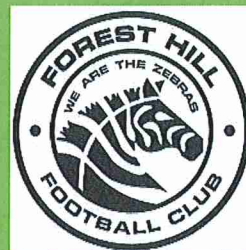

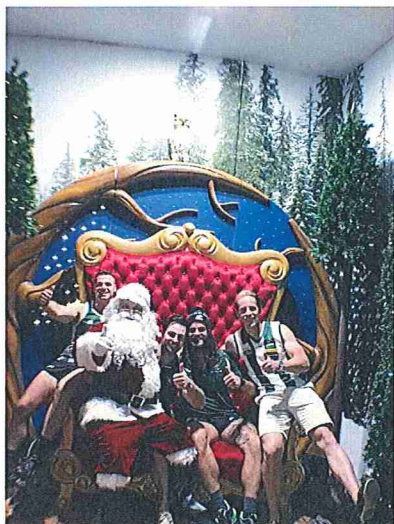
## MERRY CHRISTMAS TO THE ZEBRA FAITHFUL

## SENIORS COACHES REPORT

Season 2018 is well and truly under way. In our Pre Christmas phase of training that commenced on 13<sup>th</sup> November we scheduled 10 training sessions over a 5 week period. The main emphasis over the 10 sessions was our game plan and structure with the players split into groups, backs, midfield, forwards to work closely with their line coaches. On the topic of coaches, I would like to welcome Gareth Britten back to the club as our Defensive/Backline coach, Manny De Bono as the opposition analysis and senior coaches assistant, Scott Savage while coaching the Under 17's joins the senior coaching panel as the midfield coach and Matthew Peterson has been re-appointed as the Reserves/Development Coach and Forward line Coach. As has been well publicized this will be my last season as senior coach of the Forest Hill Football Club with senior assistant Justin Scicluna taking over as the senior coach in season 2019 in the clubs succession plan after my departure. Congratulations to Justin and its terrific that club has such stability in terms of the senior coach for season 2018 and 2019 and beyond. At the time of writing this report pre-season training has been well attended and a different structure to our training in the months of November and December to seasons 2016 and 2017. With the coaching panel assembled it has allowed more specific one on one and line group coaching which I'm sure will pay dividends when the season commences in April.
